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Course Assignments/Activities and Evaluation

Culminating Examination: Participants will undergo a comprehensive assessment with 75 questions mirroring the RBT Exam content. There is no limit on the number of attempts for this examination. A minimum score of 80% is mandatory to pass.

Video Lecture Quizzes: As an interactive method to confirm engagement with the video lectures, learners will receive Powerpoint notes with select omissions. The words to complete these notes are specified within the lecture videos. Participants must successfully complete these fill-in-the-blank quizzes with a perfect score.

Interactive Discussion Boards: Participants are expected to engage with discussion prompts on the boards, reflecting on and utilizing concepts discussed in the video content.

Data Visualization Exercise: Learners will be provided with a dataset to interpret and visualize through graphing, followed by submission of their graphical representation.

Session Note Refinement Task: Participants will refine poorly articulated session notes to exhibit professionalism and objectivity.

Terminology Mapping Exercises: Learners will be tasked with placing specific terminology in its appropriate location within provided charts or diagrams, with a requirement to achieve at least an 80% success rate.

Word Placement Activity: Learners will move the correct terms into gaps within content passages, aiming for an 80% minimum success rate.

Observational Practice - Fill in the Blanks: To practice observational skills, students will complete exercises where they must insert the correct word or symbol, such as “-” or “+”, based on behavior observations during interval recording, with an 80% accuracy rate needed.

Terminology Crosswords: Engagement with crossword puzzles will be used to reinforce understanding of terminology, with a passing score set at 80% or above.

Flashcard Matching: Students will reinforce their knowledge by matching terms with their definitions or examples on flashcards, with an 80% pass rate required.

Conceptual Knowledge Assessments: Through a series of true/false, multiple-choice, and statement selection questions, learners will validate their understanding, with an expectation to score at least 80% to pass.
